WINTER

Skirt: Mid-grey traditional pleated/panel pleated skirt (minimum of 2 pleats) available at Laser and various outlets

Blouses: Pale blue open-necked, long or **short** sleeved

Cardigan/Jumper : Maroon (Burgundy) with embroidered school logo (Laser only)

Shoes: Black, flat/small heels only (No boots, canvas or 'slip-ons'). Sturdy school shoes only. Alternative PE/sports shoes for break times only

Socks: Grey knee length socks or tights. (Maroon knee length socks may be worn but not at school events eg. Christmas concert). Grey cotton rich tights may be worn in colder weather

Vests: Plain blue or white T-shirt or vest may be worn under the blouse providing it cannot be seen at the neck

Cycle/Modesty Shorts: These may be worn under a school skirt in pastel colours, but should not be visible below the hemline.

SUMMER (Optional): Can be worn Summer Term until October half term.

Same as winter uniform except:

Dress: (year 4-6) Pale Blue and White gingham (shirtwaist type), **no White collars/cuffs**

Blouse: (year 7-8) Pale Blue and White gingham short sleeved blouse or pale blue short sleeved open neck blouse to be worn with winter skirt

Sandals: Blue, White or Black (no open toes or canvas) – flat/small heels only

Socks: Can wear White socks with summer blouse or summer dress if worn (**white socks should not be worn with winter uniform**).

SPORTSWEAR

Shoes: Predominately White trainers (no Black sides, boot styles or canvas pumps)

Skirts: Navy Skorts from Laser

Polo or Aertex Shirt: White

Socks: White ankle sports type or knee length (no stripes, colours or logos)

Sweatshirts with School Logo: available from Laser

Jogging Bottoms: Navy

House stripes (ribbons): These can be purchased from the school office and sewn onto skirts at the beginning of the school year; as we near Sports Day, they will be checked (skirts have one stripe)

Swimming costume: Plain Navy Blue, available to purchase from school (up to and including Year 8)

Swimming caps: House colours, available to purchase from school.

Pupils should wear school skirts and trousers over shorts and skorts when arriving and leaving school. Parents must ask for permission for a pupil to wear their own clothes at the end of the day for a specific occasion.

'BOYS' MIDDLE SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST (YEARS 4-8)

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WINTER

Trousers: Mid-Grey long, school trousers

Shirt: Pale Blue **long or short** sleeved

Jumper: Burgundy with embroidered school logo (Laser only)

Tie: Maroon with blue stripe, sizes 39" – 45"

Shoes: Black, (no boots, or canvas). Sturdy school shoes only. PE/sports shoes for break times only.

Socks: Grey ankle socks

Plain Blue or White T-shirt/vest may be worn under the shirt providing it cannot be seen at the neck.

SUMMER (Optional):

Can be worn during the Summer Term until October half term. Same as Winter uniform except:

Shirt: Pale Blue, short-sleeved

Shorts: Y4-6 (if worn) Mid-Grey as Lower School.

SPORTSWEAR

Shoes: Predominately White trainers (no Black sides, boot styles or canvas pumps)

Shorts: Navy shadow-stripe in bri-nylon (no logos)

Polo or Aertex Shirt: White

Socks: White ankle or knee length sports type (no stripes, colours or logos)

Sweatshirts with School Logo: available from Laser

Jogging Bottoms: Navy

House stripes (ribbons): These can be purchased from the school office and sewn onto shorts at the beginning of the school year; as we near Sports Day, they will be checked (shorts have a stripe down each leg)

Swimming costume: Plain Navy Blue, available to purchase from school, (up to and including Year 8)

Swimming caps: House colours, available to purchase from school.

Pupils should wear school skirts and trousers over shorts and skorts when arriving and leaving school. Parents must ask for permission for a pupil to wear their own clothes at the end of the day for a specific occasion.
